MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on the 17th of January 2017

Present:- Parish Councillors; Peter Dance, Teddy Forsythe, Nicholas Levett-Scrivener, Chris Norrington (Chairman), Kenneth Parry Brown, Frank Potter (Vice Chairman) and Tony Sore. Apologies for absence - Christopher Bishop

2017/1. The Chairman welcomed Councillors, no members of the public were present. The Chairman reported the resignation of Councillor Oliver Platt

2017/2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST - none

2017/3. MINUTES - The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting of the 30th of November 2016 were approved and signed as a true record.

2017/4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES - Councillors agreed that matters arising from the minutes of the meeting of 30th November 2016 should be considered at the next meeting.

2017/5. FINANCIAL REPORT - Balances (at 30/12/2016):-
Current A/C - £16504.33, Deposit A/C - £7097.73.

Cheque signed: SGF Services, 3 invoices for grass cutting (cemetery, war memorial and Peasehall Street) £1650.00

2017/6. BUDGET - The Clerk presented a proposed budget to the Council for the Financial Year 2017/2018. This was unanimously accepted with three amendments:-

- i) Salary and HMRC should be set at £3500
- ii) £3000 allocated in the 2016/17 budget for traffic speed indicators be carried forward into the 2017/18 budget.
- iii) The allocation of £500 for a feasibility study for a footpath at Sibton Road be cancelled and the £500 added to contingencies.

The revised total budget is £17410

2017/7. PRECEPT - The Council unanimously agreed to keep its tax charge at the 2016/2017 level of £50.12 for a Band D property. This would generate a precept of £11618.32. The Clerk to inform Suffolk Coastal District Council.

2017/8. PLANNING ISSUES

Planning Application ref: DC/16/5425/, to reduce the crown of an oak tree in the rear garden by 30% and to fell a decayed apple tree in the rear/side garden at 3, Hackney Road, Peasehall, - no objections.

Planning Application ref: DC/17/0033/LBC, to remove existing rough finish rendering to part front of the property because of adhesion problems and replace with smooth finish traditional lime rendering at Peasen House, Bruisyard Road, Peasehall,- no objections.

The Clerk to notify SCDC Planning Department of both decisions.
