2018/70 PLANNING APPLICATION ref: DC/18/4937/FUL

Planning application concerning the conversion, renovation and
change of use of redundant agricultural barns to form a distillery
with ancillary storage at Hill Farm Barns, Badingham Road,
Peasehall.

2018/000 The Chairman suspended the meeting at this point to
allow contributions from the public. These were:-

That the business should create 5 jobs eventually. The
development would add to diversity in the village by providing a
manufacturing facility. Wheat and barley from local farms would be
used. It is hoped to manufacture whiskey, vodka and gin. First year
output is estimated at 10000 bottles, full capacity will be 40000
bottles per annum. The effect on traffic volumes would be minimal.

2018/000 The Chairman reconvened the meeting at this point.

2018/000 It was proposed by Kenneth Parry Brown and seconded
by Norman Ball that the Council has no objections to this
application. All in favour. The Clerk to inform SCDC Planners.
