REPORT – 30 JUNE 2020

1. Motions approved by email:

- a) Support given to planning application DC/20/2083/AGO – a formalising of the farm building and farmyard drainage to allow the harvesting of rainwater runoff to be piped to an excavated lake south of the River Yox. From here it can be used to fill the sprayers on the farm and in drought years provide the opportunity to initiate spring cereal germination using an irrigator – Site of Pond in Field 250m North of Lodge Farm, Mill Lane. All in favour with the exception of Cllr. Norman Ball, Cllr. Stephanie Liston and Cllr. Roger Benstead who did not respond and Cllr. Nick Levett-Scrivener who declared an interest and took no part in the vote.
- b) Response sent to the Suffolk Coastal Local Plan Consultation on Main Modifications and copied to the Planning Inspectorate. The response is available to view on the village website.

2. Actions taken:

- a) Cllr. Nick Levett-Scrivener arranged for electricians, Pearce and Kemp of Halesworth, to move the defibrillator from the Village Stores into the telephone kiosk. The electricians waived their charge for this work.
- b) Request sent to County Cllr. Stephen Burroughes for an update on the old primary school site.
- c) Councillors invited to submit individual responses to the SALC Code of Conduct consultation.
- d) Suffolk Highways confirmed the damaged railings on Rendham Road will be repaired by 16th July 2020.
